The 2019 Special Olympics World Summer Games will be held in Abu Dhabi from 14th – 21st March, 2019. These will be the first World Games held in the Middle East. There will be a Host Town experience offered prior to the Games from the 8th – the 11th of March. This will mean the time commitment will for the Games is from March 8th – 22nd. The Games will feature seven days of competition in 24 sports. Team Ireland will take part in the following sports: **athletics, badminton, basketball, bocce, bowling, equestrian, football, golf, gymnastics, kayaking, swimming including an open water event and table tennis.**
