



## Tee Off with Gala Retail for Special Olympics Ireland

### Terms and Conditions 2020

- 'Tee off with Gala Retail' for Special Olympics Ireland in a special golf tournament inviting teams to register for a 4 person team event at the club of their choice during the week of 19<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> July and submit their team score to Gala Retail to be entered into a big prize draw.
- To qualify for entry, a team of four must make a €300/£280 donation to Special Olympics Ireland in one payment on the dedicated page at [SpecialOlympics.ie](https://SpecialOlympics.ie)
- If you cannot play and would like to make a donation or donate a prize we would really appreciate this.
- Upon receipt of donation, entrants will receive an email with a reference number for their team and scorecard – to qualify for entry into the prize draw, this reference number must be clearly written on the team score card.
- Upon receipt of donation entrants will receive an email outlining the rules and entry process.
- Participants can play at their own home club or any other club available to non-members.

### Competition Rules

- Competition is a four-person team event using 'Stableford' scoring system with the best 2 scores on each hole to count
- All scores submitted must be based on GUI handicaps
- 4 scores to count on the 18th
- 1 Score card to be submitted per entry. Specify the date you played (if you have played more than 1 game between the 19<sup>th</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> July you can submit your best scorecard)
- Max Handicap for Men 28
- Max Handicap for Ladies 36
- Full Handicap applied for scoring

- The scorecard must be signed by **two players** with all handicaps clearly marked, please specify the date you played and have your team name and the entry reference number recorded on your scorecard
- Following your round, simply take a photograph of your scorecard and submit to [teeoffgolf@galaretail.ie](mailto:teeoffgolf@galaretail.ie)
- It is really important that the photo of your score card is clearly legible, so that it can be accepted as an entry
- All scorecards must be submitted before 9pm on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July to qualify for entry into the prize draw
- Entries not submitted in accordance with these rules will be disqualified
- A virtual prize presentation will take place on the [Gala Retail Facebook page](#) on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> July at 7pm.
- Prizes will be awarded for top 21 highest scores and will be judged by official representatives from Gala Retail and Special Olympics Ireland, with the help of an independent adjudicator.
- In the event of a tie on scores, the 'count back' system will be applied to determine the higher scoring team (back 9, back 6, back3)
- Additional terms and conditions of use from providers will apply to prizes
- Redemption date of prizes is subject to availability
- No cash alternatives will be offered
