TO BE ELIGIBLE TO BECOME A WORLD WINTER GAMES VOLUNTEER IN TORINO, ITALY 2025 ALL APLLICANTS MUST:

- Be aged 18 years or over
- Be available to travel between 8th

   14th March 2025 approx (final dates
   TBC)
- Become a registered volunteer by completing the vetting process.
- Have volunteered in some capacity either at a Special Olympics event or with another organisation.
- Be willing to fundraise and ensure the deadlines outlined in this brochure are met on time.
- Satisfy vetting and visa requirements.
- Have a reasonable level of fitness as your role may include being on your feet for long periods.

#### Roles and Training

- Volunteers are expected to attend all training sessions organised by Special Olympics Ireland and/or the Local Games
   Organising Committee of the Special Olympics World Summer
   Games Turin 2025 (GOC).
- Volunteers must be willing to accept the assigned roles allocated by the Turin Games Organising Committee (GOC).
- Roles will most likely be in the areas of event and/or information services e.g. directing attendees to their destinations, managing car parks, crowd control, distributing information to attendees, awards.
- Please note this application form and process is separate from Special Olympics Ireland's Team Ireland Management or Athlete Team sign-up process.
- Volunteers will be asked to comply with the code of conduct and must have a reasonable level of fitness to be fit for the volunteer roles.

#### Fundraising

The deposit and instalments must be met by the deadlines or travel to Turin will not be guaranteed.

Please note, funds are non-refundable and will be donated to Special Olympics Ireland if you are unable to reach the targets and deadlines, withdraw or unable to meet vetting requirements.

We ask that you don't transfer funds you have raised to other volunteers.
